18. FOREHEAD: (high, low, bulging, vertical, receding, hollow, temples, tribal marks, prominent veins, etc.)
19. EYEBROWS: (COLOUR, THICK, THIN, SHAPE, PENCILED, PLUCKED, ETC.)
20. EYES: (colour, large, small, squint, peculiarities, glasses, glass eye, blind, absence of eyes, etc.)

21. NOSE: (large, small, hook, straight, flat, broken, turned up, tribal marks, or adornments, etc.)
22. MOUTH: (large, small, open, close shut, droops at corners, deformity, etc.)
23. LIPS: (thick, thin, upper or lower protruding, rouged, pal, cracked, tribal adornments, etc.)
24. TEETH: (white, discoloured, prominent, gaps, false, tribal features, filed, etc.)
25. CHIN: (receding, project, dimpled, double etc.)
26. EARS: (large, small, close to head, protruding, pierced and enlarged lobes, ornaments, etc.)
27. MARKS: (scars, warts, birthmarks, pimples, tattoo, tribal markings; in case of Africans, if circumcised and when)
28. OTHER PECULIARITIES: (gait, deformities, etc.)
29. HABITS: (fond of racing, games, smoking, drinking, women, speaks of nervous habits, snuff taker, bhang smoker, miraa eater, etc.)
30. DRESS: (give variations of European, Asian, Arab, Somali, or Africa national or tribal dress.)
31. SPEECH: (accent, stammer, drawled, high pitched, hoarse, mumbled, languages spoken, etc.)
32. LIMBS: (amputated, deformed, muscular, thin wasted, bow-legged, knock-kneed, tribal marks and tattoos.)
33. ANY OTHER INFORMATION likely to assist in identification.
34. ACCOMPLICES AND ASSOCIATES with registration or docket numbers if available.

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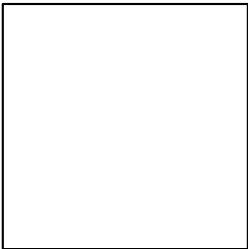
